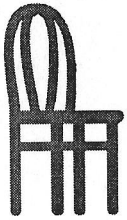

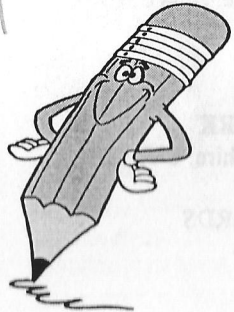
NOTES FROM THE CHAIR

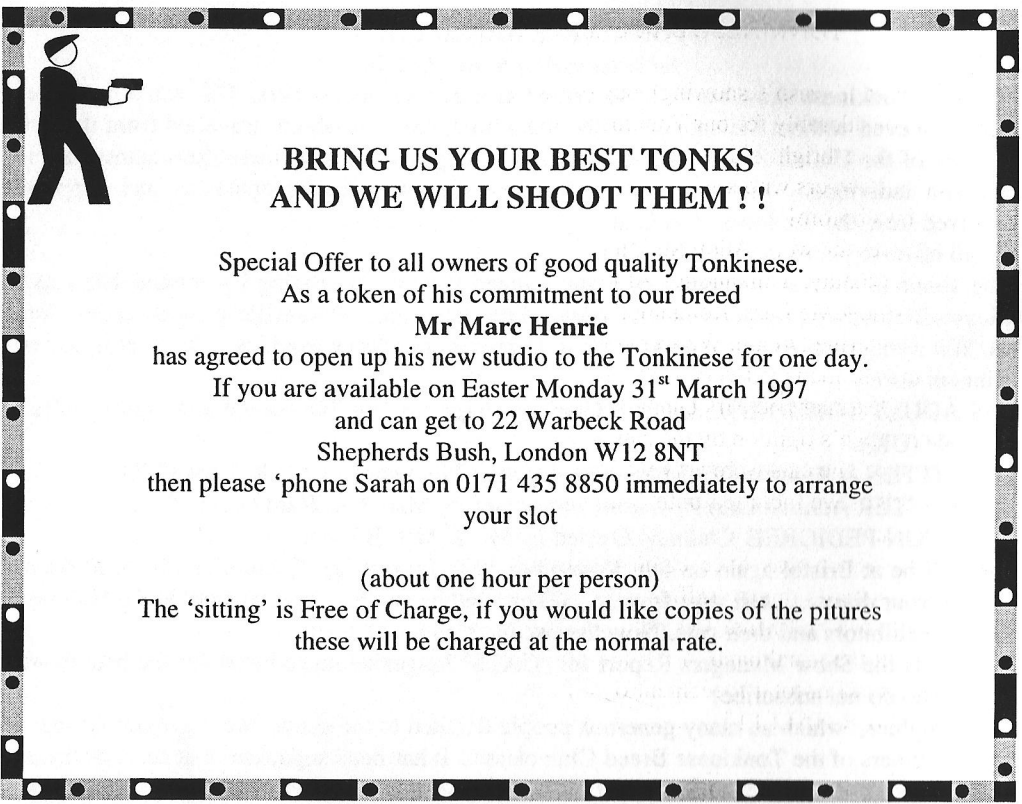

Congratulations to the Tonkinese Breed Club on their first ever show which seemed to be a huge success with a very large entry. Doreen & Sarah are to be commended on their excellent organisation, everything seemed to run on oiled wheels.

LILAC Adult Male: 1 BOC POOLE S CLARINATH NIGHTSHADOW. Stylish young boy who eventually became overall Best In Show. Well built, strong & muscular with well proportioned limbs & tail. Short silky textured coat of even lilac with deeper expression of colour on points. Very good head is well contoured, showing slight profile break, definite whisker pinch & good chin. Expressive eyes of bluish green are well set & ears are very well positioned. Overall he has typical Tonkinese appearance plus a most amiable disposition; 2 MACEY'S BONZER MERLIN. Another well structured boy of very good type, firm & muscular with limbs & tail balancing. Short close coat feels fine & silky, overall colour good with deeper expression of colour on points. Very good head has moderate wedge, well set ears, muzzle shows definite whisker pinch. Profile line has slight nose break & level chin which could perhaps be a fraction deeper. Very good eye set, colour greenish blue. Another typical Tonkinese with a gentle manner; 3 BELLION'S ROMANTICA OSCAR. Well balanced lad feeling firm & muscular. Good tail & limbs with neat oval paws. Short close coat -feeling lovely & silky, very good colour with darker colour expressed on points. Head is well contoured, moderate wedge with whisker break, slight nose break, level chin. Eye colour is light green. Ears of good shape are well placed. Good natured boy feeling nice & mature for his age, 4 MURREY-LANGLEY'S EPISCOPUSS LEONIDAS.

Young boy just over 1 year old but well grown with good firm body & well proportioned limbs Tail has good length although feels a little thick at the base. Short close coat, overall colour is good with deeper colour contrast on points. Medium head with well set ears, slight nose break, level chin, definite whisker pinch. Expressive eyes of light green. I could only award four prizes although the other two boys in this class were also of good quality: BOOTH'S SHOTONKS SHOGUN TALISON, SHARRATT'S ADOUZSH ZACHARIAH ZEUS. **Female:** 1 BOOTH'S TONKABELLA PHOEBE PERPETUA. A very elegant young lady who has very good substance & muscle for her size & age (she is not yet 1 year old). Very good tail & legs with neat oval paws, beautifully balanced. Short close coat, silky fine texture, pale lilac overall with deeper lilac on points. Head has moderate wedge which is nicely contoured. Showing definite whisker pinch, slight nose break & level chin. Expressive eyes of light greenish colour. Quite a charmer; 2 CROWTHER'S ISHOKATS AMBER AMETHYST. A mature girl of 5 years showing overall good type although her tail needed a bit more length to balance. Firm legs with neat oval paws. Short close coat texture, colour is quite good & shows contrast on points. Well shaped head with very nice profile line. Ears of good shape are very well set. Front teeth are rather ragged. Expressive eyes of good colour.

CHOCOLATE Kitten Male: 1 BOC HAAS'S MELUSINE AQUATAY. Delightful kitten with lots of style who later became Best Kitten in Show. Excellent substance & size for his age, long muscular body on firm legs with neat oval paws. Tail of very good shape & length. Lovely fine silky texture coat, colour pale chocolate with warm cast, darker chocolate contrast on points. Well proportioned head is nicely contoured, cor-

rectly shaped ears are very well positioned. Well defined profile line. Expressive greeny coloured eyes. A delightful friendly chap; 2 RICHARD'S TONKAHOLICS ARABIAN KNIGHT. Well grown kitten feeling nicely firm & muscular, balanced by a very good tail, legs & feet. Short close coat of warm milk chocolate showing darker contrast on points. Head has moderate wedge of good proportions. Ears wide set are rather large at present. Profile shows barely perceptible nose break, chin is level. Well set eyes of a good greeny colour. Rather a wriggler; 2 PRITCHARD'S TONKAHOLICS MR MISTOFOLEES. This lad was not very happy & rather difficult to judge. He felt firm & well muscled a had good weight a size for age. Medium head with definite whisker break, his muzzle appeared rather square but I think this was due to anxiety. Needs to grow into his ears. I loved his coat which was such a beautiful colour, truly a warm milk chocolate. **Female:** 1 SAVAGE'S TRAMPUSS TICKETY BOO. Well proportioned kitten feeling firm & well muscled, good limbs & tail balance. Warm milk chocolate coat with deeper colour on points texture fine & silky. Head has moderate wedge, well positioned ears, definite whisker pinch. In profile she displays slight nose break & good chin. Greenish coloured eyes well set; 2 JOLLEY'S TRAMPUSS TROUBADOUR. Litter sister to my winner. Smaller girl but has good substance & muscle, firm limbs & tail balances. Pale milk chocolate coat of fine silky texture colour on points dark chocolate. Medium wedge, ears well set, barely perceptible nose break, level chin. Greenish coloured eyes. **TORTIE Kitten Female:** 1 BOC HAAS'S MELUSINE BELLACLOVA. Elegant & very well balanced young lady feeling nicely firm & muscular. Very good tail & slenderlimbs with neat oval paws. Fine silky texture coat, short & close lying, colours bright & well mingled. Darker colour evident on mask & tail. Head has moderate wedge with well

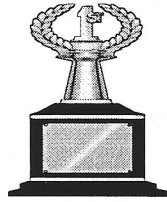

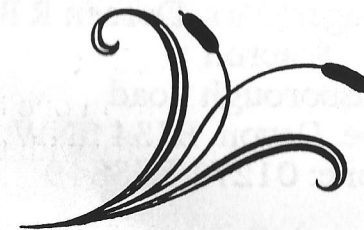
