- **Tonkinese Kitten & Studs** If anyone has kittens available please send me the details via the form on the web site; and remember to send me any stud information and/or updates.
- **TBAC Research** Recently the Tonkinese BAC has been trying to establish the size of our gene pool, but work is hampered by the lack of information from the past 5 years and more, regarding the pedigree lines of our breeding population. In the New Year we will be contacting you for information please support us.
- Registration Policy Knowing how long it takes to plan for a new stud we want to keep you as up to date as possible. As per the Autumn Newsletter, the Tonkinese BAC will be amending the mandatory DNA tests, as required, to protect the breed. The Club's discount code for DNA testing with Langford is: Meowsociety16. With the likelihood that more Tonkinese may be imported to enhance our gene pool, the TBAC has requested additional DNA tests as follows:

"b. In order to be registered as Active all first and subsequent generation male Tonkinese, shall be DNA tested negative for: Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA rdac), <u>Pyruvate Kinase Deficiency (PKDef)</u>, Burmese Hypokalemia and <u>the Burmese Head Defect</u>. The same is also strongly recommended for all female Tonkinese being registered as Active."
