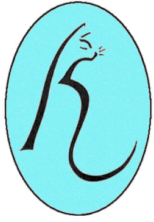

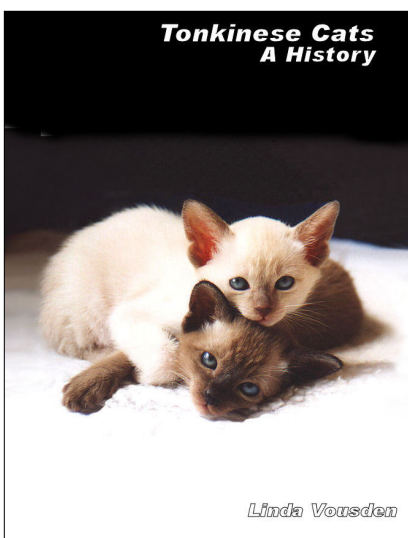
Tonkinese Cats – A History
